



POST TREATMENT INSTRUCTIONS

IV Infusion Therapy

Important Tips:

- Leave your bandage on for at least 15 minutes after your treatment
- Keep the puncture site area clean and dry after you remove your bandage
- Avoid showering, bathing or exposing the puncture site to water for at least 1 hour after your treatment
- Avoid strenuous activity or stressing the puncture site for 24 hours after your treatment

Contact Us Or Seek Medical Care

- If you develop any loss of sensation or numbness around the procedure area or in the arms where the procedure was performed
- If you develop repeated or worsening swelling at the puncture site
- If there is bleeding from the puncture area that will not stop
- If a large bruise develops around the puncture site
- If bleeding from the puncture site develops and will not stop even after pressure is applied for 15 minutes
- If redness or red streaking develops around the procedure site
- If you develop shortness of breath, rash, itching sensation, swelling of your lips, tongue, throat or other signs of an allergic reaction
- If you develop a fever
